# Pillar 1 – Spiritual

Grounding the community in Scripture, prayer, worship, and prophetic revelations.

## Objective

To strengthen the spiritual life of the community, based on Scripture, prayer, worship, and prophetic revelations, so that all teaching is rooted in faith and produces transformation.

Module	Description
Biblical Foundations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Introduction to the Holy Scriptures (7 days)</li><li>• Thematic study: Creation, Justice, Promise (40 days)</li><li>• Discipleship and Christian Doctrine (3 months)</li></ul>
Prayer and Devotional Life	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Daily rhythms of prayer (morning and evening)</li><li>• Practice of fasting and intercession</li><li>• Prophetic Prayer School (intercession circles)</li></ul>
Worship and Praise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Introduction to community worship</li><li>• School of Levites (music, choirs, instruments)</li><li>• Prophetic and spontaneous worship encounters</li></ul>
Prophecy and Revelation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Introduction to the prophetic gift</li><li>• Interpretation of dreams and visions</li><li>• Prophetic Scrolls (direct connection with SAIHGENESS)</li></ul>

## Spiritual Certification

Upon completing each cycle (7 days, 40 days, 3 months), the participant receives a Sealed Certificate of the Work, in PDF with QR Code, validating their spiritual progress.

## Pillar 2 – Technical

Practical and technological training to empower the community in essential skills for the future.

### Objective

To develop technical and practical skills — from digital literacy to financial management — that strengthen individual and community autonomy.

Module	Description
Digital Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Basic use of computer and smartphone</li><li>• Safe and ethical internet use</li><li>• Productivity tools (docs, spreadsheets, presentations)</li></ul>
Languages	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Basic English for global communication</li><li>• Introductory French and Spanish</li><li>• Practical conversation methods</li></ul>
Music and Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Introduction to instruments and singing</li><li>• Community music production</li><li>• Creative expression as an educational tool</li></ul>
Basic Finance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Family budget management</li><li>• Concept of saving and investing</li><li>• Basics of digital economy (tokens, currencies, market)</li></ul>
Entrepreneurship and Work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Initiating impact projects</li><li>• Local entrepreneurial skills</li><li>• Creating sustainable community businesses</li></ul>

### Technical Certification

Each participant will receive modular certificates (7 days, 40 days, 3 months), recognizing practical and technical achievements applied to community life.

## Pillar 3 – Community

Community formation based on service, citizenship, and networks of mutual support, strengthening the social fabric of the Work.

### Objective

To build resilient and supportive communities, where each person is an active part of collective growth, practicing justice, sharing, and service.

Module	Description
Citizenship and Social Justice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Basic rights and duties</li><li>• Access to services and community support</li><li>• Combating local injustices</li></ul>
Community Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Local impact projects</li><li>• Structured volunteering</li><li>• Solidarity workshops (e.g., health, food, education)</li></ul>
Support Networks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Formation of mutual aid groups</li><li>• Support for families in vulnerability</li><li>• Spiritual and social accompaniment</li></ul>
Sustainability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Community environmental education</li><li>• Recycling projects and sustainable use of resources</li><li>• Local gardens and cooperatives</li></ul>
Multiplication of Groups	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Creation of study and action circles</li><li>• Participatory community leadership</li><li>• Replication of the model in new neighborhoods and cities</li></ul>

### Community Certification

Participants who complete the community modules will receive a Community Service Certificate, validated by the Work and connected to the SAIHGENESS network.
